SETTING UP and STARTING GRINDER; WEAR SAFETY GOGGLES and STAY ALERT. TURN ON/OFF SWITCH (located on engine housing to ON). RAISE HANDLE BAR from BEHIND the ENGINE to a COMFORTABLE HEIGHT and PIN. BE SURE BRAKE is LOCKED. PUSH DOWN MACHINE HANDLE and SMALLER KILL HANDLE (this ALLOWS ENGINE to be CRANKED, RELEASING THIS HANDLE will INSTANTLY KILL the ENGINE) SO THAT the CUTTER WHEEL is OFF the GROUND. PULL CHOKE OUT IF ENGINE is COLD. BE SURE "ON-OFF" (PUSH - PULL) SWITCH is in "ON" POSITION. SET THROTTLE 1/2 OPEN. PULL STARTER ROPE, WHEN CRANKED ALLOW ENGINE to IDLE for a MOMENT, THEN PUSH CHOKE IN.

STUMP GRINDING PROCEDURE; PLACE CUTTER WHEEL DIRECTLY in FRONT of STUMP. USING LEVER ON HANDLE, LOCK the WHEEL BRAKE, BY PULLING LEVER BACK TOWARD the OPERATOR. MOVE HANDLE BACK and FORTH (left and right) ALLOWING the CUTTER to GRIND the STUMP with EACH PASS. CONTINUE to GRIND to DESIRED DEPTH.

HELPFUL HINTS; WHEN GRINDING OVER 8-inches (REDUCE HEIGHT as CLOSE as POSSIBLE with CHAIN SAW, PRIOR to GRINDING) ABOVE/BELOW GROUND, ADJUST HANDLE BAR for BETTER CONTROL and COMFORT. ON LARGER STUMPS, CHIPS MAY BEGIN to BUILDUP UNDER WHEELS, RELEASE BRAKE PULL, MOVE UNIT TOWARD YOU SO THAT "CHIP PILE" is DIRECTLY UNDER CUTTER WHEEL. SLOWLY LOWER CUTTER WHEEL DOWN on "CHIP PILE", ALL MATERIAL WILL BE DISCHARGED from MACHINE AREA. NEVER JAM or FORCE WORK into GRINDER! DO NOT LEAVE or TRY to OPERATE FROM ANY POSITION OTHER THAN BEHIND CONTROL HANDLE. KEEP BOTH HANDS ON HANDLE. NEVER TIE SAFETY BAR HANDLE SWITCH! PLEASE KEEP GRINDER TEETH OUT of the DIRT. UPON FINISHING WORK, RELEASE THE KILL SWITCH HANDLE BAR (ENGINE SHOULD STOP), THEN TURN THE ENGINE SWITCH to the "OFF" POSITION. PLEASE TURN THE ENGINE KEY to the "OFF POSITION" to AVOID the BATTERY FROM RUNNING DOWN.

TRANSPORTING; USE CARE LOADING/UNLOADING, WEIGHT is 400 lbs.! USE a RAMP, ADDITIONAL HELP and PULL GRINDER UP INTO TRUCK or TRAILER WHEN LOADING. WHEN UNLOADING - AGAIN USE A RAMP, HELP and HOLD HANDLE, SLOWLY EASING the FRONT of the MACHINE DOWN FIRST. REMEMBER to START RAISING FRONT END AS YOU APPROACH the GROUND LEVEL. SECURE PRIOR to TRANSPORTING! <u>CUSTOMER'S RESPONSIBLITIES</u>; OUR CUSTOMERS are RESPONSIBLE for SAFE USE and IMPLEMENTATION of this UNIT! THAT CUSTOMER BE RESPONSIBLE for SIMPLE MAINTENANCE to be PERFORMED, USE of CLEAN FUEL (GASOLINE) and OIL FLUID LEVEL CHECKED ON A CONSISTENT BASIS

(WHEN REFUELING, CHECK on a LEVEL SURFACE). on EXTENDED RENTAL (MORE THAN 24-HOURS) AIR FILTER SHOULD BE CLEANED DAILY (REMOVE FILTER, GENTLEY TAP FILTER on ITS EDGE, BLOW 30 psi AIR
